Language Area

This month we will continue to work with the language sandbox, and spelling. For Bo Po Mo Fo (ㄅ ㄆ ㄇ ㄈ). We will start again with ㄅ ㄆ ㄇ and ㄈ and will spend more time with pinyin. We are learning the Chinese characters 个, 十, 百, 千, 日, 目, 白, 一, 二, 三, 四, 五, 六, 七, 八, 九, 十。 We read the Chinese poem 三字经 (San Dz Jin) page 6, and will continue working on 登鹤雀楼 (Deng Guan Chueh Lo) . The English classroom worked with the sounds for Gg, Ll, Pp and Zz. Older children will be working with spelling and phonics. The English poems are Ladybug Ladybug and Georgia Porgie.
